BRINK & HEATH Blossoms Under NMC Umbrella

BRINK&HEATH, which NMC acquired in 2008 as part of its diversification strategy, has now developed into a multi-disciplinary engineering and construction civils company contributing increasingly to the NMC Group's well-being.

Brink & Heath is well represented in the Western Cape with operations spanning into SADC through Brink & Heath North and Brink & Heath Malawi as well as Mokwena Surfacing.

Its service offering includes concrete structures, infrastructure and township development. Backed by its 20 year industry experience, strong project delivery track record and BBBEE credentials (level 5 BBBEE rating with 26% equity in black hands) it is well positioned to capture new markets.

The successful completion of the N2 Botriver/Caledon national road upgrade for SANRAL, award of the R46 million Alexkor Mine Township and Services Upgrade tender and projects underway in Malawi are just the first steps in this direction.

Mokwena Surfacing operates as a separate company within the Brink & Heath Group. Its primary focus is the practical aspect of road resurfacing and rehabilitation and as such has reaped the benefits of the build-up to the 2010 soccer world cup inclusive of the airport access road run for Acsa and upgrade of various urban roads for the City of Cape Town.

Brink & Heath North has steadily picked up with a water reticulation project in Barkley West and a collaboration with Brink & Heath Civils on the Nature's Valley Pass upgrade in the Eastern Cape.

Shareholding in BH Plant's, a level 4 BBBEE contributor, gives the Brink & Heath group access to its comprehensive plant inventory, in-house workshop and qualified mobile maintenance support team, enhancing operational efficiency and minimising downtime risk.
